Dear Families,

Please find below an outline of our Remote Learning Plan. This will give you information on how you and your child can access learning from home, should we need to implement any future lockdown scenarios. You can find a copy of our Remote Learning Policy on the school website.

1. Whole School Lockdown

If we go into a whole school lockdown then children can access their learning through:

- Google Classroom- teachers will set English and Maths work here every morning.
- 1 piece of other subject (art, science, topic etc.) work will be set in the afternoon for KS2.
- Filmed lessons – dependent on each teacher.
- In KS1 teachers will sign post other activities for the children to do in the afternoon if they wish.
- Early Years will continue to use Tapestry.

2. Bubble Lockdown

If a class (bubble) has to lockdown then children can access their learning through:

- Google Classroom- teachers will set English and Maths work here every morning.
- 1 piece of other subject (art, science, topic etc.) work will be set in the afternoon for KS2.
- Filmed lessons- dependent on each teacher.
- In KS1 teachers will sign post other activities for the children to do in the afternoon if they wish.
- Early Years will continue to use Tapestry.

3. Children who are well and self-isolating

- Google Classroom- teachers will upload classwork here if appropriate.
- Oak National (Government funded platform) – Children will be signposted to specific lessons.

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4. Teacher absence due to COVID-19/other illness

Children will access Oak National in school.

5. Children with specific learning needs

Teachers will set specific tasks according to the needs of the child.

6. Other Information

- Tapestry/Class Dojo will still be used for communication between teachers and parents.
- Teachers will use Tapestry/Class Dojo to inform parents and children of the daily activities for learning.
- Teachers will be available on Class Dojo until 4 p.m.
- Children will be sent home with an exercise book to record their school work in.
